Rod Deakin presented the Treasurer's Report for the period 1 July 2014 to 30 June 2015. The report is attached.

Peter Wells also explained to the meeting that it had been the policy of the VPCI Committee throughout the year to return to the Victorian Petanque Clubs and their playing members essentially all the income received. The Committee was of the view that only sufficient funds should be retained to ensure the continued viability of the organisation, about \$5000.

Peter Wells further added that it was the aim of the VPCI Committee to make all of its financial and operational decisions open to all member clubs, and that all minutes of meetings and financial statements were available to any club and their playing members through the VPCI website.

Member clubs were also reminded that the fee for hosting their own Victorian Calendar tournaments was now 10% of the total registration fee collected (and not \$2 per adult player).

Rod Deakin stated that the bank balance as of 19 November 2015 stood at \$6078.32 with no significant outstanding payments to be made.

7. BUSINESS OF THE MEETING

- 7.1 Call for Nominations for President of Victoria Petanque Clubs Inc.
Election of President. There were no nomination received prior to the meeting. On a call of nominations from the floor, Andre Deramond nominated Graham Jones. Graham Jones indicated he was willing to stand as President. With no further nominations Graham Jones was announced at President of VPCI.
- 7.2 Call for Nominations for Vice President of Victoria Petanque Clubs Inc.
Election of Vice President. Prior to the meeting Graeme McIntyre was nominated to the position of Vice President and accepted that nomination. There being no other nomination Graeme McIntyre was announced as Vice President of VPCI.
- 7.3 Call for Nominations for Treasurer of Victoria Petanque Clubs Inc.
Election of Treasurer. Prior to the meeting Rod Deakin was nominated to the position of Treasurer and accepted that nomination. There being no other nominations Rod Deakin was announced as Treasurer of VPCI.
- 7.4 Call for Nominations for Secretary of Victoria Petanque Clubs Inc.
Election of Secretary. Prior to the meeting Peter Wells was nominated to the position of Secretary and accepted that nomination. There being no other nomination Peter Wells was announced as Vice President of VPCI.
- 7.5 Call for Nominations for 2 Ordinary Members of the Committee of Victoria Petanque Clubs Inc.
Election of Ordinary Members of Committee. Prior to the meeting both Guy Mercier and Antoine Buffet were nominated to the positions of Members and accepted those nominations. There being no other nominations Guy Mercier and Antoine Buffet were announced as Committee Member of VPCI.

Graeme McIntyre congratulated all Office Bearers and Committee Members of VPCI.

8. PFA PROPOSED STATE SUPER 5 ARRANGEMENTS

The VPCI Committee had decided prior to the meeting to allow a brief discussion to seek the broad views of the member clubs on the suggestion by PFA of their proposed State Super 5 tournament to replace the previous InterState Challenge (ISC).

Before the discussion commenced Peter Wells reminded those present that there would be no vote or motion on this item.

Andre Deramond was invited to outline the concept of the State Super 5 and the reasons for introducing a replacement to the ISC.

Following this, each club representative was given a short time to outline their reaction to this and state broadly whether they supported the move, and provide any points that they felt should be reviewed by PFA before finalising the State Super 5 document.

The overall view of the member clubs present was that PFA should proceed with this concept, but to ensure a gender balance in the proposed teams. The consensus was also that while it was a PFA initiative and thus a PFA event, as the majority of the games would be conducted through the State Leagues, that the State Leagues should be adequately recompensed for their work and the engagement of umpires.

Andre thanked the clubs for their input and indicated that PFA would put out a final document within a couple of weeks, and that the intended registration date for teams to participate in this event would be 31 January 2016.

Victoria Petanque Clubs Inc - 2015 AGM

Vice President's Report.

Petanque continued to grow in Victoria over the last 12 months and we have maintained our position as the most popular state in terms of the number of clubs and registered players.

The committee convened 5 times over the course of the year. They remain committed to the ongoing promotion of our sport and to encourage new players to take up the game, the support of our member clubs and the development of our players at all levels by the coaching staff. The aim is to eventually have a "club coach" in every club. They also worked closely with the umpiring department and recognised the need for non-playing umpires in timed games. They endorsed the aim to have an accredited umpire in each club and underwrote a training course which resulted in two new umpires.

Summary of the year's activities.

- The purchase of 3 shooting mats and 25 circles costing \$850 for use by clubs and coaches.
- Providing \$900 towards the cost of the very successful junior coaching clinic held at Caulfield.
- The establishment by Peter Wells of the Mypetanque.com online registration website.
- Grants of up to \$150 (per club) to member clubs for equipment, software, piste accessories etc.
- Financial support of \$300 each for Patrick Dufresne and Gerard Finette for training our State and International teams on Saturdays.
- Financial assistance of \$1000 for the junior and women's teams and their coaches in Bangkok
- Underwriting \$100 for the SE Regional coaching clinic with 60 players from 6 clubs at Flinders by Guy Bahler.
- Underwriting an umpire training course conducted by Danny Green.
- Financial assistance of \$600 for our team to the cancelled ISC in WA who had prepaid their flights & accommodation and made the trip to play in a tournament.
- Introduction of a rudimentary player ranking system.
- Increased the Non Playing umpire fee for timed games to \$100 per day.
- Sport workshop conducted by Peter Wells at Main Ridge.
- Funding for a public "Come & Try Petanque" day at Mornington conducted by MPPC.
- Receiving \$850 from the PFA to promote the sport of Petanque in Victoria.
- Conducting 4 State Championship titles for the calendar year.

It would be remiss of me not to thank Max Chaperon for his years of service and contribution as past President and committee member of our association.

I want to take this opportunity to thank our dedicated coaches and umpires for all their fine efforts throughout the year.

I also wish to thank the committee for their considerable contributions over the year with a special mention to Peter Wells for his extensive input with the implementation of new technology and his administration skills in running our organisation.
